


# GPA, WHAT IS THAT?

# What about English test requirements?


#### You may be required to take the **TOEFL** or other English proficiency exams.

Each college is different and has different requirements and exceptions. It is best to contact the International Admissions office directly, of each of your chosen schools, and let them know about your status as a Dual Diploma student to see if you are still required to take the English proficiency

exam.

### Where do I find information about the TOEFL?





You can request your transcripts through this link:

Remember to complete the respective webform correctly with your personal information. Please note that it can take up to 10 days to process and receive the electronic transcript. There is a fee associated with the official transcripts. If you are an American citizen, you will likely follow the requirements for domestic applicants.

It is best to confirm beforehand with your chosen schools by contacting the International Admissions Office and letting them know more information about your unique situation.





When filling out the application in Common App, you can add a second high school. When you click on Common App, you should then click on Education. It will give you the option to search for a second school.

In the area for additional information, you can mention that they are still a student with our school. The name of our school as it is listed in Common App is: Academica International Studies.


#### You can ask teachers, counselors, and sometimes coaches for letters of recommendation.

Each college will have specific information about the letters of recommendation requirement including how many you need and who you can ask.

If you are applying to an American college, the letters of recommendation should be in English. You can ask your Dual Diploma teacher(s) for a letter of recommendation.

It is helpful to send the person some information about yourself such as what you want to study and why, your accomplishments and strengths, and your resume or CV.

### Who can I ask about letters of recomendation?



If you have the option to choose either the SAT or the ACT, do some research about each test to see which one you would be most confident in taking.

Check out the descriptions of each exam on the official websites. Try a free practice test for each exam to see your strengths and areas for improvement. Then make your decision, register, and study!
