





Special reminders!

Common App is open for the academic year as of August 1st!

If you are planning to apply to a university that accepts applications via the Common App, you can go ahead and create a free profile to get started on the application process.

If you're not sure how to use Common App, check out our helpful tutorial on <u>our CAP Corner</u>. Remember that some universities may not accept applications via Common App. Double check to be certain! Don't forget that some American universities can have application deadlines as early as the end of October and/or November 1st! Make sure you prepare in advance!

Things to prepare



Complete any required exams!

If you have not done so already, be sure to complete any required exams (example: SAT or ACT) as soon as possible so that your scores are ready in time for the application's due date.





English proficiency exams (example: TOEFL)



Request letter(s) of recommendation

Confirm in advance with the universities that you're applying to and see if you are required to take an English proficiency exam to apply. Reach out to those who you would like to write a letter of recommendation on your behalf. Be sure to give the person ample time to complete the letter in advance.





Other reminders





Use a calendar and reminders to ensure that you have all of the required documents prepared ahead of time. Remember that there can be different due dates for different universities.



Stay engaged!

Don't catch a case of senioritis and disregard your coursework. Be sure to continue to try your best and keep your grades up all year! Continue to participate in any extracurricular activities.





Request your official transcripts from AIS & your home school.

Remember to give your schools enough time to prepare any required documentation.

Explore your options


If you're not ready to apply to college at this time, be sure to review your options and create an action plan with your parents/guardians. Make a list of your choices and think about your priorities!
